Award Background

The BCCPAC Educational Award was established to honour Ona Mae Roy, President of the BC Home and School Parent-Teacher Federation (now BCCPAC) from 1978-1980. Ona dedicated her life and work to improving the quality of life for all children through the advancement of their health, welfare and education. Through this award, those who have contributed to it, along with BCCPAC, hope that children will continue to benefit in memory of a valiant lady.

Award Criteria

The award is open to any **Grade 12 student** at a BCCPAC-member school* planning to pursue post-secondary studies (academic, technical, vocational or training). It honours a well-rounded student demonstrating varied interests and an understanding of the importance of **parental involvement** in education.

One award of \$1000 is granted annually.

A completed application form with supporting documents must be received by the BCCPAC office, either by mail or fax, by **February 28**.

Award Application Checklist

All applicants must submit:

- A cover letter outlining good citizenship, leadership, sportsmanship and community service interests.
- Two letters of reference; one from an educator and one from a community member (not a relative).
- Copies of Grade 11 and Grade 12 report cards to date
- A 300-500-word essay on the value of parent involvement in education (with reference to the role of PACs, DPACs and/or BCCPAC.)
