2017.2 Advocacy for Single Occupant Inclusive Washrooms

Be it resolved that BCCPAC advocate for at least one single occupant washroom in each school to be designated inclusive for all. Be it further resolved that BCCPAC advocate for additional capital funding to cover the cost of building, or the conversion of an existing bathroom to, at least one single occupant inclusive washroom in schools where they do not exist

2017.3 Advocacy for Single Occupant Inclusive Change Rooms

Be it resolved that BCCPAC advocate for at least one single occupant change room or combination change room/washroom in each school to be designated inclusive for all. Be it further resolved that BCCPAC advocate for additional capital funding to cover the cost of building, or the conversion of an existing bathroom to, at least one single occupant inclusive change room or combination change room/washroom situated close to the school gym where they do not exist.

That the Ministry of Education, Skills and Training and the BC Teachers' Federation ensure that the issues surrounding gay, bisexual and trans-gendered youth shall be included in the anti-harassment policy rather than be a separate curricular program developed in the BC Public School System.
