To help planning and saving early for their children's post-secondary education or training programs, the B.C. Government contributes \$1,200 to eligible children through the B.C. Training and Education Savings Grant (BCTESG). Children are also eligible to receive funding through the Canadian Learning Bond (CLB) and Canadian Education Saving Grant (CESP), which are national programs.

## **Who is eligible?**

- The child was born in 2006 or later
- Must be residents of British Columbia
- The child is the beneficiary of a Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP) with a participating financial institution

## **Where do I apply?**

- At the participating financial institution



## **When can I apply?**

When your child turns six. After that, you may apply any day before their ninth birthday.

### **Extensions:**

If your child was born in 2006, you have an extension until August 14, 2019, to get the grant.

If your child was born in 2007, 2008, or 2009, you have an extension until August 14, 2018.



# Provincial Scholarship Program



## Provincial Scholarship Program

- ❑ The program's purpose is to recognize student achievement and encourage students to pursue post-secondary education or training.
- ❑ Recipients must meet the basic eligibility requirements and the specific requirements for each scholarship.





## BC Achievement Scholarship

- Recognizes the top 8000 graduates in the province.
- Based on achievement in Grades 10, 11, and 12 courses that satisfy 2004 Graduation Program requirements, including elective courses.
- A cumulative average percentage is calculated and forms the basis for determining recipients, who receive a \$1250 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.
- Students **do not apply**



## **District / Authority Scholarships**

- 5500 scholarships distributed across school districts and independent school authorities that recognize graduating B.C. students for excellence in their chosen area of interest or strength. Areas include: Fine Arts, Physical Activity, Community Service.
- Winners receive a \$1250 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.
- Students contact their school for application information.



## BC Excellence Scholarships

- 55 BC Excellence Scholarships available to recognize well-rounded B.C. graduates.
- Recipients will have demonstrated service and leadership, both at school and in their communities, and shown aptitude and commitment to their chosen career paths.
- They will receive a \$5000 scholarship voucher to use for post-secondary tuition.
- Students must be nominated by their school in order to apply for this scholarship. Only one student from each school may be nominated. Students can inquire at their school.



## Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship

- Awarded to 20 outstanding high school graduates who have demonstrated a commitment and aptitude for a career path in K-12 teaching.
- Winners receive a \$5000 scholarship voucher to redeem when they are registered and attending an approved K-12 teacher education program at one of BC's nine Faculties of Education.
- Application is on the Ministry webpage.
